<p>Sample in Bidding Data</p> <p>100 Nos .38 Special Ball Ammunitions (Live), 100 Nos 9x19 Ammunitions (Live), and 50 Nos 9mm Blank Ammunitions as samples shall be handed over to the Police Central Armoury, Field Force Headquarters, Colombo-05 on or before 14.08.2024 at 1500 hrs, prior to the bid opening day. The receipt for the samples handed over should be attached with the bid. Note: The sample ammunitions will not be returned.</p>	<p>Suppliers clarified that samples are impossible to submit with the bid since it will take more time to import from the suppliers. Therefore, they requested an extension of the sample submission period.</p>	<p>Decision:</p> <p>The sample submission date is amended as follows:</p> <p>Suppliers can submit the same amount of samples as mentioned in the bidding document on or before 14/10/2024, even after the bid closing date.</p>
<p>Packaging details in the technical specifications of all ammos</p> <p>Macro: 1000 rounds, ADR 1.4S, UN0012 certified fibreboard case 317x130x135mm (Appendix 2) Micro: 50 rounds (fibreboard box w/ plastic separator) (Appendix 3)</p>	<p>Suppliers inquired if it is critical to follow these standards for packaging, noting that most suppliers use their own packaging with international standards. They asked if there was any critical requirement for the mentioned packing details.</p>	<p>Decision: It is decided to amend the Packing details of the technical specification of all ammo types as follows:</p> <p>Packing Requirement: Macro: 1000 rounds in a steel box Micro: 50 rounds in a plastic or fiber container The package should comply with the above macro and micro rounds requirement. Packing materials should use internationally accepted methods to protect the lifetime of the ammo and need to be covered in an airtight steel box.</p>

<p>ITB 14.3 The bidders shall quote for the full quantity.</p>	<p>Suppliers inquired if it is necessary to quote all Blank ammos and live ammos, or if it could be evaluated separately for each ammo type and award the bid.</p>	<p>Decision: Since this procurement needs to obtain licenses from multiple authorities, it is necessary to select one supplier for all types of ammos. Therefore, no change to the original clause will remain.</p>
<p>Sample in Bidding Data 100 Nos .38 Special Ball Ammunitions (Live), 100 Nos 9x19 Ammunitions (Live), and 50 Nos 9mm Blank Ammunitions as samples shall be handed over to the Police Central Armoury, Field Force Headquarters, Colombo-05 on or before 14.08.2024 at 1500 hrs, prior to the bid opening day. Note: The sample ammunitions will not be returned.</p>	<p>Suppliers inquired if it is allowed to present samples which are already supplied to a previous tender to Sri Lanka Police.</p>	<p>Decision: It is not allowed, and suppliers should submit the required amount of samples for this tender.</p>
